For those accepted to present posters:

Your poster cannot be larger than 4 ft X 4 ft (1.2 m X 1.2 m). Please bring thumbtacks if you can; we will have an unusually large number of posters this year.

For those of you accepted to do oral talks:

As the entire conference will be livestreamed, you cannot use your own computer. All talks must be loaded on to the conference computers.

You will be asked to load your talk the morning you are due to present between 7-8 am. Please do not plan on loading your talk during coffee breaks or lunch breaks. Our student volunteers will be attending to other activities. For example, if you are due to present at 1 pm on Monday, please either load your talk on Sunday, or before 8 am on Monday.

Unless you are a keynote speaker or award winner, your talk is 12 min long with 3 min allowed for questions. Please plan your talks accordingly—we will have concurrent sessions and attendees will switching rooms to hear talks at specified times.

For most rooms, there will be 2 large screens at the same level as the podium (not behind you). We will have lavalier microphones, slide advancers and pointers. We will attempt to have Presenter View available.
